Inquests taken before Mr. Coroner Sylvester:

At Patney, on George Harper, aged 7 years. The deceased was employed by Mr. Mackrell, and was engaged ploughing with two horses, when the near horse knocked him down with his fore leg, and he was kicked by the hind leg in the head, causing concussion and laceration of the brain, of which he died the following day. Verdict, "Accidental death."
