Poole Keynes

Is in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District of Cirencester, and Diocese of Gloucester, and two miles from Kemble and 5 from Cirencester. The register of the Church of St. Michael dates from 1632, and the living is a rectory of the net value of £198, in the gift of the Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster. Area, 1,135 acres, rateable value, £1,819; population 143. Letters arrive from Cirencester, and are despatched at 8.30 a.m. and 5.15 p.m. There is a Money Order and Telegraph Office at Kemble.

OAK WELL is half a mile south west.
