1838

We the Undersigned, being Tythe owners or duly authorized Agents of Tythe owners, within the parish of POTTERNE, in the county of Wilts, whose interest is not less than one fourth part of the whole value of the Tythes of the said parish, do by this notice in writing under our hands, call a PARACHIAL MEETING of Landowners and Tythe owners, within the limits of the said parish, for the purpose of making an agreement for the GENERAL COMMUTATION of TYTHES, within the limits of the said parish, pursuant to the provisions of an Act passed in the sixth and seventh years of the reign of his late Majesty King William the Fourth, initiuled "An Act for the Commutation of Tythes in England and Wales;" *And we do hereby also give notice*, that such Meeting will be held at the GEORGE INN, in the said parish, on FRIDAY the sixth day of July, at the hour of ten in the forenoon. Given under our hands this first day of June, 1838.
