### **Proposed Memorial Tablet in Swindon**

Referring to the Mayor's statement re the above at the last meeting of Swindon Town Council (fully reported in our last Friday's issue), we have received a copy of the list containing the names of officers, non-commissioned officers and men who fell or died during the South African War. At the request of the Mayor, we publish the list with the view of the names of the Swindon men being selected therefrom by our readers, in order to assist the Mayor in getting a complete list of the names of the Swindon men. Following is the list:-

Nominal roll of officers, non-commissioned officers and men of the 1st, 2nd and 63rd Company Staff and Gun Section. 1st Battalion Imperial Yeomanry, who were killed or died in South Africa during the late war:-

Roll of non-commissioned officers and men of the 2nd Battalion Wiltshire Regiment, born in or near Swindon, who were killed or died during the war in South Africa from 1899 to 1902
