On the 26th ult. In London, Robert, second son of Mr. T. Merrett, late of the Bell Inn, Potterne, to Martha, second daughter of Mr. Joseph Price, of Worton. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal 06 August 1859**

1870

Devizes District Petty Sessions, Monday last

The "Bell" , Potterne was transferred from John Merrett to Thomas Durnford. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette 28 April 1870**

1900

Police Court

William Davis and John Ford, savvies, pleaded guilty to stealing a timepiece, value 4s, the property of Charles Smith, of the Bell Inn, Potterne, on the 12 th, and were each sentenced to 14 days hard Labour. **Wiltshire Times and Trowbridge Advertiser 17 March 1900**
