

~ The Will of Mary Manning of Pottern 1760 ~

This is the last Will and Testament of me Mary Manning of Pottern in the County of Wilts Spinster Imprimis I Give and bequeath unto my Brother John Manning of All Cannings in the said County of Wilts Gentleman the Sum of ffive Pounds for Mourning Item I Give and bequeath unto my Nephew John Manning Hazeland and to my two Neices Sophia and Mary Hazeland the Sum of One hundred pounds each the same to be paid them by my Executrix hereafter named within twelve Months next after my Decease But in Case the same shall not be Demanded and paid at the time above Appointed for Payment thereof Interest to be allowed them for the same after the rate of three Pounds Pr Centum Pr Annum and no more And Lastly All the Residue and Remainder of my Estate of what nature or kind I Give and bequeath the same unto my Sister Martha Hazeland of Pottern aforesaid Widow whom I Do hereby Nominate and Appoint full and sole Executrix of this my said last Will and Testament In witness whereof I the said Mary Manning have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twentieth Day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Mary Manning
