Committed to the House of Correction, Devizes James Razey, for one month, for leaving the service of John Goodman, of Preshute. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 21 November 1833**

### **1838**

Committed To Bridewell, Marlborough Henry Hurlbatt, for twenty-one days, for destroying fish at Preshute **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838**

Committed To Bridewell, Marlborough Benjamin Shepherd, for re-examination, charged with having committed an abominable offence at Preshute **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838**

Committed To Bridewell, Marlborough John Bishop, for one month, for destroying fish at Preshute **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838**

Committed To Bridewell, Marlborough Edward Pocock Goodchild, for two months, for destroying fish at Preshute **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838**

### **1843**

Wilts Epiphany Sessions Stephen Maslen and James Measom, charged with having stolen two fowls, the property of William Somerset, at Preshute. Guilty: Maslen, 9 months imprisonment, Measom, 2 months imprisonment and once whipped. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**
