Committed to the House of Correction, Devizes James Razey, for one month, for leaving the service of John Goodman, of Preshute. Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 21 November 1833

1838

Committed To Bridewell, Marlborough Henry Hurlbatt, for twenty-one days, for destroying fish at Preshute **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838**

Committed To Bridewell, Marlborough Benjamin Shepherd, for re-examination, charged with having Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838

Committed To Bridewell, Marlborough John Bishop, for one month, for destroying fish at Preshute **Wiltshire Independent**, **Thursday**, **22 February 1838**

Committed To Bridewell, Marlborough Edward Pocock Goodchild, for two months, for destroying fish at Preshute Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838

1843

Wilts Epiphany Sessions Stephen Maslen and James Measom, charged with having stolen two fowls, the property of William Somerset, at Preshute. Guilty: Maslen, 9 months imprisonment, Measom, 2 months imprisonment and once whipped. Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843
