

THIS is a wide district surrounding Marlborough, and consists of the hamlets or divisions of Manton, Clatford, Manton Down, Wick and Temple Barton, and the Bath Road, and the suburban portions of St. Margaret's and Elcot. The parish is in the Devizes Division of Wilts, Marlborough Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District, and Diocese of Salisbury. The register of the Church of St. George dates from 1607; and the living, a vicarage of the net annual value of £170, is in the patronage of the Bishop of Salisbury. At Manton, the principle hamlet of the parish of Preshute, is a school for girls and boys. The Marquis of Ailesbury (who is Lord of the Manor), Lord Manton, Messrs. Hurditch and Harding and Mr. J. B. Wroth are the principal landowners. Area, 4,834 acres; rateable value, £4,900; population, 1,848. Letters arrive through Marlborough, and are despatched at 10.15 a.m., 4.30 p.m. and 7.15 p.m. Marlborough is the nearest Money Order and Telegraph Office. Postal Orders are issued and paid here. For NANTON, letters arrive from Marlborough. Manton Down, comprising a training establishment, is almost a hamlet in itself, with a population of over 100; this is about a mile and a half north of Manton and Clatford.

CLATFORD, 11/2 miles west from the Church, is hamlet of this parish.

CLATFORD PARK, is 21/2 miles south west of Marlborough.

WICK and TEMPLE, respectively 4 miles and 3½ miles north from the church, are also hamlets.
