



### **Almost Married 1921**

A bridegroom's omission led to the postponement of his marriage at Bremhill (Wiltshire), and the bridal party and their friends had to return home disconsolate. The bride lives at Bremhill, and the banns had been published there, but the bridegroom had failed to have them read at Wootton Bassett where he lives. As a result the Vicar refused to marry the parties, the bride being informed of the position on her arrival at church.

### **Western Gazette Friday 9 September 1921**

The unlucky couple are Harry John Hunt of Purton and Miss (still Miss) Caroline Reeves of Foxham, Bremhill. They were to have been married at the Bremhill church, near Bath, and while the bridegroom and friends were waiting for the bride, the vicar, Rev A E G Peters made the disconcerting discovery that Hunt had not had the banns published in his own parish of Wootton Bassett.
