A Hamlet to the west of Purton, anciently called Bredon Wood. A charity derived from land in Cricklade and Purton is distributed the first Friday after January 6th in sums varying from 15s. to £4. The church was erected in 1868. Primitive Methodist Chapel. Letters via Purton.
