William Murphy, alias George Armstrong, alias John Riley, was apprehended by Inspector Huntley at Ramsbury, from a description in the Police Gazette, charged with obtaining money in no less than four counties of magistrates and clergymen under pretence of having been robbed of his furlough and pass and being unable to join his regiment, the 29th foot. He was handed over to the Worcestershire police.
