This is the last Will and Testament of me Philip Zillwood of Ramsbury in the County of Wilts Gentleman I direct that all my just debts and ffuneral and testamentary expences may be paid as soon as conveniently may be after my decease I give and bequeath all my Personal Estate and Effects of what nature or kind soever after payment of my just debts and ffuneral and testamentary as aforesaid unto my dear Wife Elizabeth Zillwood for her own absolute use and benefit for and during the term of her natural life and after the decease of my said Wife I give and bequeath the following Legacies unto the several persons herein after mentioned their respective Executors Administrators and Assigns that is to say unto William Spearing John Spearing and Amelia Spearing Nephews and Niece of my said Wife the sum of One hundred pounds Apiece and unto the Children of the late Mr John Pontum in his life time of the Strand London Hatter also Nephews and Nieces of my said Wife the sum of Nine hundred pounds to be equally divided between and amongst them share and share alike unto my Niece Christiana daughter of my Brother William Zillwood the sum of One hundred and fifty pounds unto my Nephew the son of my said brother Charles ffifty pounds unto my Nephews and Nieces the Sons & daughters of my Brothers Richard Zillwood and John Zillwood the sum of One hundred pounds to be equally divided between and amongst them share and share alike And I direct that in case of the decease of any or either of the said Legatees above mentioned during the lifetime of my said Wife the Legacy hereinbefore bequeathed to such one or more so dying as aforesaid shall be paid to the Personal Representative or Representatives of such deceased Legatee or Legatees And hereby revoking all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore made I do appoint my said Wife sole Executrix of this my Will In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day of September 1838 P Zillwood
