## **1842**

Another prebendal stall in the Cathedral Church of Sarum has become vacant by the death of the Rev. Walter John Kerrick, clerk, which event took place at the rectory Paulersbury, Northamptonshire, about a fortnight since. The deceased was formerly fellow of New College, Oxford, and succeeded to the above living in right of his fellowship. He was the Senior Prebendary in Salisbury Cathedral having been collated to the prebend of Alton Australis, in the year 1792. The revenues of this preferment will now be received by the Ecclesiastical Commissioners, as in the case with all other sinecure preferments which are appropriated towards the augmentation of small livings, but the vacant stall will be filled up by the Bishop of Salisbury, who is the patron, in due course. **Devizes & Wiltshire Gazette, 15 September 1842**

## **1870**

**The Diocese of Mauritius** On Sunday afternoon the newly consecrated Bishop of Mauritius preached in the Cathedral on behalf of the missions of his diocese. At the close of the sermon a collection was made amounting to £10 14s. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 17 December 1870**
