Wednesday the King's Plate was won by Mr. Freeman's Woodlark, beating Mr. Hyde's bay horse Pig.

Thursday, the City Plate was won by Mr. Powell's Sweetbrier, beating Mr. Hyde's Pig.

Same day, the Members' Plate of £50 was won by Mr. Clarke's Merry Andrew beating Mr. Stacey's Bumper, and Mr. Phillips's Hydalgo, which ran out of the course.

Friday, the £50 Maiden Plate was won by Mr. Weeks's Harvest, beating Mr. Crook's bay colt.
