

## CORONERS INQUESTS



## Salisbury 1800-1849

## 1835

On Saturday last, an inquest was taken at our Council Chamber, by R. M. Wilson, Esq., coroner for this city, on the body of Mr. H. White, who, while returning from Weyhill-fair, on Thursday evening, was so much injured by his van, laden with hardware goods, passing over his body, that he died soon after reaching his home in Milford-street. A verdict of "Accidental Death," was, after hearing the evidence, unanimously recorded. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 19 October 1835
