## **New Market House**

We announced in our last this undertaking would be commenced as soon as the share-list is filled. We understand that of the sum on £12,000 capital, £9,525 has been subscribed, leaving the sum of £2,475 required to complete the subscribed capital. It is worthy of note that the inhabitants and members of this city have already contributed £6,450, being more than one-half of the whole required capital. It only remains for those agriculturalists in the district, who have not hitherto subscribed, and who as a class will derive such important benefits from the erection of a covered market-house with stores, &c., to assist in the raising the small amount required to complete the capital.
