



Louisa Case - Trained Nurse

Louisa Case was born in the March Quarter of 1855 and registered in the Warminster Registration District. Census returns give her birthplace as Upton Lovell.

The 1861 Census at Wadwick, Box records:-

Louisa, 6, born in Upton Lovell, with her parents, Jacob, 32, a carter, and Maria, 33, sisters Ellen 7, and Charlotte, 4, and younger brothers, William, 2, and Frederic, 5 months.

The 1871 Census at Milford records:-

Louisa Case, 16, a labourer, with her parents, Jacob, 41, agricultural labourer, Maria, 42, younger sister Matilda, 14, a scholar, and 6 younger brothers.

The 1881 Census at Fremington House, Barnstaple, Devon records:-

Louisa Case, 26, Visitor, a visiting sick nurse, born Warminster, Wilts to household of Mrs. Eliza Yeo, 78, a widow.

The 1891 Census at 70 Hull Street, St. George Hanover Square, London records:-

Louisa Case, Professional Nurse, 35, born in Wiltshire, single, resident, in the household of Annie Spiers, 47, and her son Alex Archibald, 21, and a number of servants.

Her younger sister Charlotte Matilda Case, born in Britford, was also a Trained Nurse.
