NOTICE is HEREBY GIVEN,

That a VESTRY MEETING of the INHABITANTS of this PARISH, who are rated to and pay the Poor-rates thereof, will be held in the VESTRY ROOM, on FRIDAY, the TWENTY-SEVENTH day of SEPTEMBER instant at TWELVE o'clock at Noon, to nominate and elect an ASSISTANT OVERSEER of the POOR of the PARISH, and to determine and specify the duties to be by him executed and performed, and to fix such salary for the execution of the said office as by the inhabitants of this parish in vestry assembled shall be thought fit. And the said vestry will, at the time and place aforesaid, upon their electing an Assistant Overseer, determine if any and what security shall be required and taken from the said Assistant Overseer for the faithful execution of his office, and make such orders there on as shall be deemed expedient or necessary.
