


St. Katharine's, Savernake Monument Inscriptions

Was Erected By Mary Caroline Herbert, Wife Of
George William Frederick, Marquis Of Ailesbury
A.D. 1861
In Memory Of Her Mother Katharine Woronzoff
Countess Of Pembroke And Montgomery
Through Whose Liberality
She Has Enabled To Build It

This Church was reconstructed
1952 after damage sustained from
a great explosion in Savernake
Forset during the World war 1939-45
The electric light fittings were
provided by public subscription among
the parishioners and installed in 1953
To the Glory of God and in
Commemoration of the Coronation
of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II
on 2nd June 1953

Byron	Robert	<p>(Church exterior wall tablet) In Memory of Robert Byron Only Son of Eric and Margaret Byron One Time of Savernake Lodge Who Lost His Life At Sea by Enemy Action off the North Coast of Scotland on His Way to the Middle East on 24th February 1941 Aged 35 Years</p>
Wasey	Cyril Walter Carleton	<p>(Church exterior wall tablet) In Loving Memory Cyril Walter Carleton Wasey, M.C. Captain. The Royal Warwickshire Regt. Attached Royal Flying Corps. Chevalier of the Legion of Honour Mentioned in Despatches Dearly Loved Son of G. K. and S. Wasey and Great Grandson of Col. F C. Marsden, C.B. (Deputy Commissioner of Ferozepur During the Mutiny) Born Sept. 29th 1893 Killed in Action in France Octr. 28th 1917 and Buried at Aubigny <i>[Epitaph]</i></p>

Lost At Sea 4th April 1893 And Of His Only Brother John George Thomas Wentworth Byng Born th Narch 1870. Who Was Attaché at Paris and Died There 6th January 1894 Sons Of Henry Byng and Henrietta His Wife Born, Countess Dannelskiold Samsøe. <i>[Epitaph]</i></p>
