Savernake



SAVERNAKE is an ecclesiastical parish formed in 1854, and comprises North and South Savernake, in which are situated the hamlets of Cadley and Brimslade, and part of the parishes of Burbage and Preshute. It is in the Devizes Division of Wilts, Marlborough Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District, and Diocese of Salisbury. The register of Christ Church situated at Cadley, dates from 1851, and the living is a vicarage of the net yearly value of £127. Area, 8,000 acres; rateable value, £3,146; population, 450. Marlborough is the nearest post town and Telegraph Office. The pillar box is cleared at 11.30 a.m. and 7.30 p.m.
