



### **A Wiltshire Divorce Suit**

In the Divorce Divisions yesterday, Mr. Justice Barnes, had before him a case in which Jeremiah Woodford, farmer, of Sedgehill, Wilts, petitioned for a divorce on the ground of his wife's misconduct with his nephew, Frank Harris. According to the evidence for the petitioner (for whom Mr. Bargrave Deans appeared), the parties were married at Batcombe, Somersetshire on the 13th March, 1884. In June, 1891, the correspondent went to reside with them, and it was subsequent to this date that the alleged misconduct took place. Evidence having been given, his lordship granted a decree nisi.
