Bankruptcy of Charles Hollingsworth Tidbury 1870

In the matter of Charles Hollingsworth Tidbury of Seend, in the parish of Melksham, in the county of Wilts, Innkeeper, a bankrupt.

Samuel Wittey of Devizes in the county of Wilts, Attorney and Solicitor, has been appointed trustee of the property of the bankrupt.

The Court has appointed the Public Examination of the bankrupt to take place at the Office of the Registrar of this Court, situate in Abbey Street, Bath, on the 14th day of September 1870 at one o'clock in the afternoon.

All persons having in their possession any of the effects of the bankrupt must deliver them to the trustee; and all debts due to the bankrupt must be paid to the trustee. Creditors who have not yet proved their debts must forward their proofs of debts to the trustee.
