In the Divorce Court yesterday, Mr Justice Langton granted a decree nisi costs and the custody of the child of the marriage to Mrs Vera Naomi Helen Ferris, living at Hill Side, Seend Cleeve, Melksham, whose husband, Mr George Henry Guy Ferris did not contest the charge of misconduct.

Mr and Mrs Ferris were married in 1928, and lived at various places including Avon Road, Devizes.

According to the petitioner's case the marriage was unhappy because of the respondent's conduct. In consequence of a letter, addressed to the husband, which Mrs Ferris found in his room, she brought the present proceedings, alleging his misconduct with a girl who had been employed at the house as a maid.

Mrs Ferris gave evidence in support of her petition and called a witness Miss Gwendoline Violet Griffiths, Supt of the Salisbury Refuge, Rolleston Street, Salisbury.
