

Seend Funeral Report

Mrs Annie M Orchard

The funeral of Mrs Annie M Orchard, of 33 Kipling Avenue, Bath, who died on January 3nd after a long illness, took place on Thursday afternoon at Locksbrook Cemetery, after a service at St Luke's Church, Bloomfield Road. The Rev W J Hopkins vicar, officiated at both the church and cemetery. Mrs Orchard was well known in the district, having lived there about 35 years.

She was a native of Seend, Wiltshire, and, 43 years ago, married Mr Ernest Orchard, a well-known Bath coach builder, now retired.
