Funeral Report

Mrs F E Salisbury

Amid the appropriate setting of a perfect autumn afternoon the funeral took place at Hinton Charterhouse on Monday of Mrs F E Salisbury. Mrs Salisbury, who was 85 at the time of her death at 74 Tisbury Road, Hove, Sussex, was the eldest daughter of the late Mr Ambrose Awdry, DL, JP, of the Manor House, Seend, Wilts, and Pulteney Street, Bath. Mrs Salisbury married the late Mr Thomas Dodson Salisbury in 1881 and they were resident for many years at Hinton Abbey, where Mr Salisbury died....

The committal was taken by the Rev Vere Awdry, of Box, a cousin of the deceased lady.
