Mr James C Clapp

The funeral of Mr James C Clapp, of the old established coopering and turnery business, Clapp Bros, Walcot Street, took place at St Michael's Cemetery of Saturday, the Rev G C Williamson officiating.

The deceased was one of the few surviving members of the old First Somersetshire Rifle Volunteer Corps, and chairman for many years of the Rational Friendly society.
