

Henry Hungerford Ludlow-Bruges

Henry Hungerford Ludlow-Bruges, MA. SCL, of Seend House, Seend, who died on the 28th February last, aged 56 years, son of Mr W H Ludlow-Bruges, MP for Bath and Devizes, appointed as executrix and executor of his will, dated 14th July 1901, his sister Miss Eleanor Ludlow-Bruges of Rodney House, Trowbridge, and Mr Anthony Henry Huxtable of Dorchester, who have valued his estate at £23,508 15s 10d.

The testator bequeathed to his executor £2000, to his sister Agnes £2000, to his sister Bertha £500. to his half-sister Augusta Dale £1000, to Nurse Fenson £100 and he left £1000 to the official trustees of the charity funds for the purpose of distributing coal to the most deserving poor of Seend, and he directed his executor to erect a board in Seend Church setting forth his benefaction. The testator left the residue of his property to his said sister Eleanor Ludlow-Bruges.
