

Lísette Henríetta Ludlow-Bruges

The will has been proved of Mrs Lisette Henrietta Ludlow-Bruges, of Richmond House, St Lawrence, Jersey, widow of Richard Ludlow-Bruges and the daughter of the late Col Digby Hamilton, who died on July 27th last. She bequeaths:

All her real property in Jersey and £2000 to the Melksham Hospital, Wilts; £100 a year and her letters, papers and personal effects to her niece Kathleen Hamilton; £1000 to George Shute; £100 to Gussio Wallington; £50 a year to her sister Frances Hamilton; £100 each to the executors, Mr Desreaux and Mr Le Marchand; And the residue of the property to the Melksham Hospital, conditional on the trustees thereof erecting a wing or addition to the hospital, not exceeding a cost of £10,000, and to be named the "Richard Ludlow-Bruges Ward". In addition to the estate in Jersey (the value of which is not recorded in the message sent us) she leaves estate in England valued at £168 1s 8d.

We understand Mrs Ludlow-Bruges lived at Seend some years ago, and also resided for a time in Bath before going to live in Jersey. Her husband, Mr Richard Heald Ludlow-Bruges died in 1907.
