Notice is hereby given, that if any person shall harbour the said Richard Scot, he will be prosecuted for so doing as the law directs; and whoever shall give information of the said Richard Scot to the said Daniel Barnes, so that he may be secured, shall be rewarded for their trouble.

The said Richard Scot is near six feet high, of a dark complexion, with straight dark coloured hair, and had on when he went away a dark brown coat, with leather breeches.”
