William Henry Hunt of Acrefield, Seend, near Devizes, who pleaded that his action was an error of judgment was fined £3 and had to pay £2 11s 6d costs at the Devizes Borough Police Court yesterday, for driving a car without due care and attention. He was represented by Mr W F Long of Bath, who entered a plea of not guilty.

The case arose out of an accident near Shane's Castle on the Bath Road, Devizes, on the afternoon of January 19, when it was alleged that Hunt, in overtaking a timber wagon, collided with a motor lorry proceeding in the opposite direction.

Sidney Arthur Mead, of Limehouse, the driver of the lorry, said Hunt pulled out from behind the wagon and collided with the lorry "right amidships".
