#### 1819

The names of those who were nominated for Sheriffs by the Lords of the Council, at the Exchequer, on the Morrow of Saint Martin, in the sixtieth year of the Reign of King George the Third, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen......

#### 1827

At the late sale of the effects of Capt. Fellowes, at Potterne, a granary of large dimensions, was purchased by Mr Scott of Seend. This granary has been since safely conveyed to its destination, a distance of several miles, without the slightest derangement, under the able direction of Mr B Glass and Mr Ferris, two eminent farmers in the neighbourhood.

### 1836

One Pound Reward - Lost at the Brutton Races, a Gold Mourning Ring. Motto - "Mr John Nevill, died October, 1810, aged 73". Whoever will bring the above ring to H Williamson, Seend, near Devizes, shall be paid the above reward. - Seend Sep 28 1836.

September 1836

The inhabitants of Seend, Wilts, with a view of diminishing, as far as possible, in the parish and neighbourhood, the many evils arising from and excess if beer shops, have resolved, at a public meeting, not to sign certificates under the new act unless it was made to appear to their satisfaction that the licensed public houses were insufficient for the accommodation of the public, and that the person applying was himself a man of sober and industrious habits, likely to maintain good order, and to repress the evils
