



We regret to record the death of Mr Ambrose Awdry (aged 73) of Seend and 35 Pulteney Street, Bath, which took place at this Bath residence on Thursday after a long and painful illness. He was buried at Bathwick Cemetery on Tuesday in the presence of a large number of sorrowing relatives and friends.....

The Bath Chronicle says: The deceased gentleman was a member of the old Wiltshire family of that name, and had lived in Bath for many years. He was a member of the Bathwick Burial Board, and years ago, we believe, filled other official positions in the parish. Of late he had been a regular worshipper at the Abbey and was a sidesman of the church. He was of a retiring disposition, and never cared to take any public office, preferring the quiet of private life. An amiable, estimable man, he will be missed by a large circle of friends.
