Letters of Administration of Personal Estate of Mr. Thomas George Bruges dated 14th November 1888

In Her Majesty's High Court of Justice Be it known, that at the date hereunder written, Letters of Administration of the personal estate of Thomas George Bruges, late of Semington in the county of Wiltshire, Gentleman deceased, who died on 19th day of October 1888 at Semington aforesaid, a bachelor and intestate, were granted by Her Majesty's High Court of Justice at the Principal Registry of the Probate Division thereof to Thomas Bruges the natural and lawful father and next of kin of the said intestate, he having been first sworn well and faithfully to administer the same.
