Salisbury, County Petty Sessions, Tuesday. Before Earl Radnor and a full Bench. William Newton, Francis Newton, Charles West and Cornelius Henstridge, labourers, of South Newton, were summoned for assaulting John Holmes, at Stapleford, on Sunday, the 11th inst. Complainant was on his way to chapel on Sunday evening, when one of the defendants threw a stone and some mud at him. Complainant could not say which of the defendants threw at him, and the case was dismissed.
