

Mad Bull Gores Farmer

Mr. George Rhind Tutt, of Brooklet Farm, Stapleford, Wiltshire, drove away a mad bull with a stick last night after the animal had gored and seriously injured his brother, John. Mr. J. Rhind Tutt was detained in hospital with severe abdominal injuries. The animal broke its tether and ran after John, who stumbled as he tried to escape.

Brother Collapsed

Mr. George Rhind Tutt today told a reporter: "I helped my brother to his feet, and he walked for 10 yards and then collapsed. The bull knocked me down recently."

The bull was hunted by farmers during the night and was shot this morning.
