



Reward to Find Fire Starters

A fire broke out at Steeple Ashton on Wednesday night, between twelve and one, on the premises of the Rev. Mr. Hay and Mr. Butcher; it is supposed from the circumstances of the flames being observed to issue forth at nearly the same time, that it was the work of an incendiary. A sheep house, containing about six sacks of potatoes, and a stack of hay, was consumed on Mr. Hay's premises. On Mr. Butcher's farm, eight loads of stubble were on fire at both ends.

A reward of 200 guineas is offered for the discovery of the offenders.
