COUNTY PETTY SESSIONS      Tuesday      Before the Right Hon, Viscount Folkestone, Colonel Baker, J. H. Jacob, and Edward Hinxman, Jnr, Esqrs.      David Winsor, a youth about 16 years of age, was charged with trespassing in pursuit of game, on the 21st January, on the lands of T. P. Swayne, Esq, at Langford. In defence he said he did not earn enough money to keep himself, and was obliged to do something to make up. This being the first offence, he was fined in the mitigated penalty of 5s and costs, or in default of payment a fortnight's imprisonment.      **Salisbury & Wilts Journal 29 January 1853**

**1871**

Salisbury - County Petty Sessions, Tuesday before Earl Radnor and a full Bench.      Ann Whatley was summoned for assaulting a little child named George Diaper, at Steeple Langford. Defendant denied the charge, and the case was dismissed.      **Western Gazette, 8 December 1871**
