Also of Mary Anne, Wife of Henry Godolphin Biggs, Esq., of Stockton, & second Daughter of Willm. Wyndham, Esq., of Dinton: born Jany. 23rd., 1798, died Feby. 12th. 1838. Also Arthur Willm. Biggs. Major of the 7th Hussars, youngest Son of Harry Biggs, Esq. Born Augst. 9th.' 1804, died Novr, 2nd. 1840. Also of Harry Biggs, Esq., of Stockton born Decr. 4th., 1766, died May 30th 1856. And of Margaretts Anne, his Wife born Augst. 31st. 1783,died Octr. 8th. 1861. Also of Emma, Wife of Harry Farr Yeatman, Esq. And Daughter of Harry Biggs, Esq. Born Jany. 23Rd 1811, died Feby. 9Th 1875. Also of Henry Godolphin Biggs, Esq., of Stockton born July 4th. 1803, died Feby. 19th .1877.</p>

Greenhill	Henry	HENRY GREENHILL Esq. Son of JOHN GREENHILL of Shipleafton in the County of Wilts Esq. & PENELOPE his Wife: Daughter of Richard Champneys of Orchardley in the County of Somerset Esq. Born in this Parish the 21 st of June 1646 Went to Sea very young made many voyages to the West-Indies, & visited most other parts of the known World. In the Year 1676. He did the Dutch Signal Service by burning & destroying several French-ships at Petit Guavas for which he was generously rewarded by the Lords of their Admiralty In 1680 The Royal African Company sent him to Cabo Corso Castle their Agent General and Chief Governor of the Gold-Coast of Africa In 1685 he was elected Elder Brother of the Trinity-House of Deptford-Strond, to the Poor of which Corporation he was a good Benefactor In 1689, made Commissioner of the Transport Office & in 1691 appointed one of the Principle Officers & Commissioners, of the Navy. He laid the Foundation & finished the Buildings of her Majties. Dockyard near Plymouth where he died the 24 th of May 1708 & lies Inter'd near this Place.
