## Short Biography

### of Revd. Henry Good

“Henry Good A.B. Born at Winburne – Minster in the County of Dorset the 19<sup>th</sup> of June 1764 was presented th this Rectory the 7<sup>th</sup> of January 1789 by the Honble. and Right Reverend Browlow North Bishop of Winton – intitited the 8<sup>th</sup> by the Honble. and Right Reverend Shute Barrington of Sarum and included the 31<sup>st</sup> by Henry Williams Curate. The present Rectorial House was begun building in April 1790 which was finished April 1792. The house – offices – garden &c. cost towards fifteen Hundred Pounds the old house was in Ruins, it stood where the present Garden is – only 95 Pounds paid by Mrs. Inness, Widow of the late Incumbent for Dilapidations. In 1791 the Rector commenced A:M. and thw 11 June 1795 married and came to Residence”.

This Entry was made July 1795 by \* Henry Good D.D. Father of the Rector. Senior Minister of the Collegiate Church of Winburne – Minster and Rector of Iwerne – Courtney and Shaston St. Rumbold in the County of Dorset (\* He was 71 when he wrote this & in good Health & Spirits)
