Private Arthur John Johnson

Private A. J. Johnson, Service No: 10271, Date of Death 27th February 1915, aged 21. 1st Battalion, Wiltshire Regiment.

Buried at Kemmel Chateau Military Cemetery, Belgium Grave ref; G.26.

Son of William and Julia Johnson, of Netherhampton, Salisbury.

Arthur John Johnson was born in the Shaftesbury, Dorset (includes Motcombe) Registration District and was registered in the December Quarter of 1893

In the 1901 census at Knook Street, Knook, Heytesbury Arthur Johnson, aged 7, is living with his parents, William Johnson, 34, a groom, and his wife, Julia, 32, and brothers and sister, Frederick,9, Eli, 4 and Daisy, 2, the children all born at Motcombe, Dorset.

The 1911 census, at Stockton, Heytesbury records:- Arthur Johnson, born Motcombe, Dorset, son, 17.

Arthur is commemorated on Stockton War Memorial.
