Son of Sr. Richard Hoare Fometime Lord Mayor Prefident of Chrifts Hofpital and Member of Parliament for the City of London</p> <p style="text-align: center;">.....</p> <p style="text-align: center;">He had a well-grounded, and therefore an infelexible, Zeal For the Faith, Difcipline, and Worfhip of the Church of England. He gave by his laft Will two Thoufand pounds For Erecting and Encouraging Charity Schools and Work-houfes: The profits and produce of two Thoufand pounds more, to be apply'd yearlt for ever in purchafing and giving to the Poor the Holy Bible, the Common Prayer, and the Whole Duty of Man: and left one Thoufand three Hundred Pounds to othet Charitable ufes. His Soul want to God March the 12th, 1724 in the forty eighth year of his Age He married Jane Daughter of Sr. Willm. Benfon Knt. by whom he had XI Children; of which teo Sons and three Daughters now Survive. This Monument was erected at Her expence Being now his Mournfull Widow, as She was His moft faithful and affectionate Wife</p>

Aged 80 years.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Henry Hoare Esq. To whom this Memorial is erected Married first, Anne, Daughter of Samuel, Lord Masham By whom he had a Daughter, who died, aged 8 year, in 1755. By his second Wife, Susan, deceased in 1743, Daughter & Heiress of Stephen Colt Esq. He had Three Sons & Two Daughters Henry – who died soon after his Birth in 1729: Henry – born Decr. 22Nd 1730, & died at Naples in 1752: Susanna – born Arl. 15Th 1732, married first, to Charles Lord Boyle, afterwards Lord Dungarvan, Eldest Son of John, Earl of Cork & Orrery: Secondly, to Thomas, Lord Bruce, now Earl of Ailsbury: She died in Feby. 1783 Colt – born Novr. nl. 1733, died in May 1740; Anne – born June 27th 1737, who being married to Richard Hoare, of Barn-Elms in Surrey, Esqr. And having given Birth to two Sons, (Henry Richard – born & buried in 1757 Richard Colt – born Decr. 9Th 1758) Ezpired on the 5th of May 1759. leaving a lively Image of many amiable Virtues imprerfsed on The Hearts of all who had the happinefs of Knowing her gentle and engaging Character.</p>

Hoare	Henry Hugh Arthur	<p>This Tablet is placed here to the memory of Sir Henry Hugh Arthur Hoare Bart of Stourhead House & of Alda his wife both of whom died on the 25th day of March 1947 he in his 82nd year. He was patron of the Benefice of Stourton and Churchwarden for many years ~ In 1946 he presented Stourhead House with its Gardens and grounds – including the Bristol Cross and King Alfred's Tower – to the National Trust He also gave 2000 acres of farming land for the upkeep of the property.</p>
Hoare	Henry Colt Arthur	<p>In Memory of Captain Henry Colt Arthur Hoare only son of Sir Henry Hugh Arthur Hoare of Stourhead Wavendon and Oxenham Bart. And of Alda his wife Born at Wavendon on July 30th 1888 he was educated at Harrow and Trinity College Cambridge and on August 1st 1914 joined the Dorset Yeomanry. He served in the Gallipoli and Palestine Campaigns, was wounded at Mughair Ridge on November 13th & died of wounds on December 19th 1917 in Raseltin Hospital at Alexandria where he rests in the Hadra New Military Cemetery</p> <p>This tablet is erected by his Father and Mother in memory of the best of sons. “Nothing is here for tears, nothing to mail Or knock the breast, no weakness, no contempt Dispraise or Blame – nothing but well and fair; And what may quiet us in a death so noble”</p>

Daughter of John Maximillian Dyer M.A. Born 27th April 1918. He lost his life in Service of his Country and the British Council through enemy action at sea on 7th December 1942. Aged 24.</p>
