Administration of W. Quarrell Shadwell

Swindon County Court Business Before Judge Gwynn James

W. Quarrell Shadwell, carpenter, of Upper Stratton

This debtors' total liabilities ran up to £44 19s. 3d. and he applied for an administration order to pay this off to the extent of 10s in the £ by instalments of seven shillings a month. He was, he said, at present out of employment, and his wages were, when in work, 25s. a week. He had one child, but the latter did not earn anything. The reason he was unable to pay his debts was that he had been subjected to much pressure from his creditors, and a judgement was obtained against him on the 20th November 1900, for the sum of £20 11s. 11d. which amount he was unable to pay. His wife had been ill, and he had been out of employment for a considerable time. The application was opposed, and it was stated that the majority of creditors in value were against the order, and his Honor therefore made an order for the payment of the debts at 20s. in the £ by instalments of 13s. 4d. a month
