Stratton St. Margaret 1700-1799

1757. On Wednesday last Thomas SAUNDERS the younger, of Stratton St. Margaret, labourer, was committed to our County Goal, by Mr. Justice Freke, for breaking open the dwelling house of Bradford PAGE, of Stratton aforesaid, in the night time, on the 2nd instant, and stealing a great coat, hat, shirts, stockings, three loaves of bread, and other things, which upon examination he confess'd.

1784 William GINGELL, Salisbury Court, August 30. charged with stealing a jack afs, in the parifh of Stratton St. Margaret, in this county, the property of Grace LEWIS.
