

## *Newspaper Notice*

### *David Bell Alexander of Stratton St. Margaret*

*(Andrews index cards: the information below appeared in a couple of newspapers Wiltshire Herald Advertiser in 1951 & the Glasgow Herald in 1951)*

Alexander - **David Bell Alexander**, otherwise **David Alexander**, late of The Hostel Stratton St. Margaret, near Swindon, Wiltshire, died there on 26<sup>th</sup> September 1950. His MOTHER is REQUESTED to APPLY to the Treasury Solicitor (B.V.) Storey's Gate, St. James Park, London. (Estate about £1,200.)

Late of the Hostel Stratton St. Margaret near Swindon Co. Wilts. died there 26.9.1950, a bachelor (~~without any known relation entitled to share in estate.~~)

According to information in possession, true name of deceased was David Bell Alexander but he was also known as **David Alexander**.  
From Statement : Deceased a bastard.
