Leisure Facilities

The Leisure Centre was built in 1978, after a Parish poll, on what was once a tennis court on the Glebe lands, originally paid for under the old 1d Business Rate, the Parish took over full funding after the 'Poll Tax' farce of 1989 when the Business Rate was removed from Parish Councils, it was abolished in 1992

but no replacement funding was put in place for Parish councils. In 2013 the Parish decided to refurbish the centre with will include the addition of an AGP (All weather Grass Pitch).

Meadowcroft Community centre & Parish offices were opened 3rd September 1985 by Parish Chairman and Mayor of Swindon.
