Car Steel Strike

The 1200 skilled men on unofficial strike at the Pressed Steel Company's car bodies factory at Stratton St. Margaret, near Swindon, decided at a mass meeting yesterday to stay out until their claim for 9d. an hour increase is met.

It is estimated that between 50,000 and 60,000 men in different parts of the country are directly affected by the strike, now in its third week.
