



## The Wheatsheaf

33 Dores Road (no 18 in 1923-1930, no.30 in 1970), The earliest deed is J Bailey selling to Eowden's 'Sun' Brewery of Highworth in 1840. Sold in 1871 for £71. It was demolished and rebuilt in 1872 and again in 1961 by Ushers, around 1997 it was owned by Wadworth's. Empty and up for sale in 2013, started trading again Jan 2014, closing permanently in 2017. Demolished 2019 for housing.
