



Upper Stratton Farm

Stood opposite school in Green Road where Orchard Grove is now, originally a grain farm.

1860 as 'Home Farm' a dwelling house with farm building, yard, gardens and about 45 acres arable and pasture land. Includes 3 cottages in occupation of John MORSE, Mary MULCOCK & William BOWLES. Land Tax £5, Annual Corn Tax 4s 5½d. Put up for sale as part of Tuckey Estate. *Swindon Advertiser 09-07-1860.*

1899 Put up for sale by Henry KEMBREY, with 2 cottages. 2a 1r 4p, Land Tax 12s 4d. *Swindon Advertiser 28-07-1899.*

1901 Thomas Kembry in occupation.

1904 Joseph Stratford when elected to Workhouse board *Swindon Advertiser 01-04-1904.*

1924 Henry Norris farmer, paid rates of £33 13s. 8d.

1931 John TILLEY, father-in-Law, dies 03-08-1931, aged 79. *North Wilts Herald 07-08-1931*
