W. H. Smith & Sons built their UK Distribution centre at Greenbridge in 1965/6 (built by H. F. Bailey (consultant architects Johns, Slater & Haward), with their major staff move being in 1975.

The 380000 square foot warehouse set on 17 acres was opened by Alderman H. G. Lewis on July 15th, 1967.

It was announced in Feb 2017 that they were knocking down the offices to replace with a housing development. The Warehouse is to remain.
